

## AACD Residency Program Clinical Requirements

- a. Inlays/Onlays- 10
  - a. Laboratory or CAD/CAM fabricated
- b. Posterior Composites- 20
- c. Posterior Crowns- 10
- d. Anterior Composites
  - a. CL-III: 10
  - b. CL-IV: 10
  - c. Diastema Closure: 5
  - d. Veneer: 6
- e. Indirect Restorations
  - a. Anterior single units- AACD Type 1: 2
  - b. Anterior single units- AACD Type II: 2
- f. Tooth replacement: Case Type III - 2  
Fixed Bridge or Implants
- g. Periodontal Plastics - Tx Plan and oversight or Perform clinical procedures
  - Gingivectomy / Crown Lengthening: 2 cases
  - Grafting - 1 case
    - Connective Tissue or Allograft
- h. Diagnostic Procedures:
  - a. Mount cases with appropriate bite and Face-Bow: 5
  - b. Occlusal analysis: 5
  - c. Mock-up and equilibration when indicated: 5
- i. Orthodontics: Where possible

Cases will need to be documented with the following images:

1. Prep-Op photos and x-ray
  - a. What best makes visible the tooth or teeth being restored
  - b. Anterior cases require the AACD Accreditation views, plus repose
2. Restoration removed
3. Final preparation
4. Temporization / prototype
5. Final photo and x-ray
