

Dr. John R. Calamia is a Full Professor, and a Director of Aesthetics for the Department of Cariology and Comprehensive Care, New York University College of Dentistry, New York City, New York. He has taught Restorative Dentistry and dental material science at NYU Dental Center for 40 years and is recognized both nationally and internationally as co-developer of Etched Porcelain Laminate Veneer Technology. His research, articles, and presentations on porcelain etching and Silane coupling agents led to his placement of the earliest recorded Etched Bonded Porcelain Veneers in October of 1982 and these restorations are still successful 37+ years later. He is very active in research, teaching, and private practice and he describes this combination as the perfect marriage within the profession. He is currently a Board of Director for the American Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry and has been elected and served as a BOD for 12 of the last 15 years.
