The Review Solution's Impact on Medical Practices: A 5-Month Assessement

In a 5-month survey of medical practices (primarily in the dental space) that have been using The Review Solution and collecting an average of 56 reviews per month, we have seen a number of marked improvements in those practices' chosen review sites and local Google search results.

Part 1: Impact on Medical Practices

With practices that had been receiving reviews organically for as many as three years, we saw an average increase of 187 percent in posted online reviews in just five months of using The Review Solution. This means that these practices were able to nearly double their online reviews in less than one-sixth of the time, with zero negative

reviews being posted through The Review Solution's collection process.

Of the reviews posted, 29 percent have gone to Health-Grades and 28 percent to Yelp — the two most vital sites when it comes to attracting new, younger patients. Other review sites that received a significant number of posted reviews in the 5-month period include Google+, Vitals, Wellness, and RateMDs. With the balance between vertical-generic and vertical-specific sites, both the practices and the doctors can see improvement to their respective listings simultaneously, allowing for a greater overall impact.

Significantly, this drastic increase in online reviews led to an average rating increase of 1.8 stars when looking at all impacted review sites collectively. This means that within a five-month period the medical practices surveyed here were able to turn 2-3 average star ratings into 4-5 average star ratings. According to a Harvard Business School study, a 1 star increase on Yelp can result in a 5-9 percent increase in revenue. Thus, assuming the validity of this finding, a medical practice that is actively using The Review Solution service, can expect to see a revenue boost within less than five months of use.

The medical practices surveyed here also saw dramatic shifts to their Google search results page 1. Because 92 percent of all Google search traffic can be attributed to page 1 search results, and page 1 only consists of 11 or fewer listings, it's no surprise that medical practices want to ensure that each of those listings are working for the business in a positive way. Using The Review Solution for five months allowed medical practices to see an average of three additional positive Google search listings per search term

This can mean one of two things: 1) that a negative listing, such as a low star-rating on a review site, turned into a positive listing due to an increased star rating or, 2) a review site that was previously off page 1, moved onto page 1 due to an increase in positive review activity. In addition, medical practices using The Review Solution saw an average increase from five review sites per page 1 search results, to seven review sites per page 1 search results.

Part 2: Impact on Local Search

Medical practices know that reviews are not just about how the practice looks online, but how it compares to similar practices in the same vicinity. When patients are looking for a new doctor, it is a game of compare and contrast. New patients aren't simply deciding "yes" or "no" to one practice, they are deciding which of the many medical practices to try. With Google being the leading search engine by a wide margin, Google Maps is often the default location specific search tool being used to find nearby businesses, meaning Google+ reviews are often a significant factor when it comes to comparing options.

To see how clients of The Review Solution matched up to their competition after five months of collecting reviews, we did location-specific searches for each practice surveyed here, comparing our clients to their eight geographically closest direct competitors. Results showed that the competing medical practices averaged four Google+ reviews with a 3.2 star rating, while practices using The Review Solution averaged 13 Google+ reviews with a 4.7 star rating.

In almost every case, The Review Solution client beat out its direct competitors in terms of number and sentiment of Google+ reviews by a significant margin. Based on research that dug into how a business can outrank its competition on Google Local, it was found that a business needs 133 to 150 percent more reviews than their local competitors. Medical practices using The Review Solution for five months had an average of 325 percent more reviews than their direct competitors.

Surveying medical practices that have been using The Review Solution for 5 months leads to the conclusion that The Review Solution positively impacts a medical practice's number of reviews, review site ratings, Google search results, and Google Local rankings for like businesses. This, in practical terms, means potential patients are more likely to find these practices, choose these practices, and thereby impact these practices' overall revenue.

AACD APEX Scholarship Offers Students Education They Don't Get in Dental School

Por the past four years, AACD has offered dental students the chance to attend its annual scientific session at no charge through the APEX student scholarship program. The award is valued at nearly \$1,700, but the experience students receive is priceless.

"How many dental students can say they've learned from specialists such as Newton Fahl, John Kois, and Frank Spear?" said Tara Ferris, a 2013 APEX recipient. Ferris, who attended Marquette University, noted that the "wealth of knowledge" she acquired was immeasurable.

In addition to tuition, students' airfare and hotel expenses are covered. They're also given an annual AACD membership.

APEX was created to help attract current dental students to the Academy, encouraging them to retain their member status as they progress in their careers and attend future meetings. When interviewed about APEX in 2013, Ferris said she planned to attend future AACD meetings. She did—AACD 2014 in Orlando.

APEX also seeks to cultivate students who have leadership potential, those who might run for positions on AACD Boards or committees. But more than anything, APEX helps get dental students excited about cosmetic dentistry education, which is rarely offered in the scope of a traditional dental school curriculum.

Walberto Cantu, a 2014 APEX Winner and Marquette University student, agreed.

"As dental students, we are limited to the training and education that

we get at school," Cantu said. "The courses that are offered here are second to none. I took classes ranging from dental implants, five layering technique restoring a Class IV lesion, to how to increase the profit of your practice."


Randy Mitchmore Releases Book:

r. Randy Mitchmore, an AACD Member who practices in Houston, Texas, has released a new book, "The Gift of a Life Smile."


The book is geared toward consumers who would like to find a dentist who meets their needs but are unsure of how to go about doing so, and for dentists who are looking for a way to better care for their patients.
